ACTIVITY

“Dark Galaxy vs. God’s
Good World” Spinner

Materials

- Paper plates
- Black and bright markers/crayons
- Star stickers
- Spinners (for spinning arrow)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Divide the plate into two halves.
2. On one side kids draw God's good world (stars, planets, happy people).
3. On the other side draw darkness entering (scribbles, broken stars, etc.).
4. Attach a spinner arrow in the center.
5. Write: "Sin brought darkness."

Teaching moment:
