# ACTIVITY

Luma Buddy Foam Softie

## Materials

- 2 foam star shapes (5 inch)
- Yarn (pre-cut lengths)
- Plastic needle (shared or per child depending on supply)
- Cotton stuffing (small handful)
- Googly eyes (2)
- Marker (shared)

# INSTRUCTIONS

1. Give each child 2 foam stars.
2. Help them line up the stars and punch holes around the edges.
3. Show them how to lace the yarn in and out through the holes.
4. When they are halfway around, pause and have them add stuffing.
5. Finish stitching and tie off the yarn securely.
6. Add googly eyes and draw a smile.
7. Attach the verse tag.
8. Tip: Younger kids will need help threading and tying. Keep holes spaced wide enough for easy lacing.
