### **Rescue Begins**

# ACTIVITY



## Pass the Light

Concept: Light spreads from one person to another

### Instructions

Setup:

Kids sit in a circle or small group

Give each group one object (ball, beanbag, or paper ball)

### How to Play:

Leader starts to count out loud

Kids pass the object quickly

When the leader says “STOP,” the student holding it responds

What They Say

### Younger Kids:

“Jesus is the light”

“Jesus brings light”

### Older Kids:

“Jesus is the light of the world”

Say the next part of the memory verse



# ACTIVITY



## Leader Flow

- **Round 1:** Pass and say a simple phrase
- **Round 2:** Increase speed
- **Round 3:** Say part of the memory verse
- **Round 4:** Answer a discussion question

## Add-In Questions

- What does “light of the world” mean?
- Where do people need light?
- How did Jesus bring light in the story?
- How can you show Jesus’ light?

## Debrief

Did you notice how fast the light moved around the circle? It did not stay with one person. That is what Jesus does. He brings light into our lives, and then His light spreads to others.

## Materials

- One small object per group
- Optional music or leader voice

# DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

## 1st–2nd Grade Questions

1. What did Jesus say about Himself?
2. What happened to the blind man?
3. What does light help us do?
4. Can you think of something that feels scary in the dark?
5. How does Jesus help us when we feel scared or sad?





# DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

## 3rd–5th Grade Questions

1. Why do you think Jesus called Himself the “Light of the World”?
2. The blind man couldn’t see. What are some ways people can be “blind” without realizing it?
3. What kind of darkness do people experience today (fear, sin, loneliness)?
4. How has Jesus brought light into your life personally?
5. What would it look like for you to bring light into someone else’s life?

Dear Jesus, thank You for being the Light of the World. Thank You for coming into our darkness and bringing hope, love, and healing. Just like You helped the blind man see, help us see You more clearly every day. When we feel scared, lonely, or sad, remind us that You are with us.
