Setup

- Every player gets:
 - 1 half-sized pool noodle
 - 1 full-sized pool noodle
- Players place the full-sized noodle down the back of their shirt so it sticks up behind their head
- Place a solo cup upside down on top of the noodle
- Spread players out inside the play area
- Rec leaders spray water during the game for extra chaos



INSTRUCTIONS

How to Play

On “GO,” every player battles at the same time. Players use their half noodle to try and knock other players’ cups off while protecting their own cup.

If your cup falls off your noodle:

- You are OUT
- You must leave the play area immediately

Last player with their cup still standing wins the round.

Rules

- Only hit cups
- No hitting faces or bodies
- No grabbing noodles or cups
- Players must keep moving
- If your cup falls, you are out
- No putting hands on your cup to protect it



INSTRUCTIONS

Power-Up Ideas

“Bowser Mode”

Rec leaders spray extra water into the arena

“Speed Boost”

Players must move only by fast walking or skipping

“Blue Shell Round”

Leaders can lightly swat at cups with noodles too

“Final Lap”

Shrink the play area for the last players remaining

Winning

Play multiple rounds.

Each round winner earns points for their Galaxy Crew.

The team with the most points becomes the:

“MARIO KART CUP CHAMPIONS!”
